How is it done?
The Process of artificial removal
Waste Products and Excess water
from the body that might have
accumulated due to kidney failure
HOW IS IT DONE?
Blood is removed from the body by use
of a machine or filter called
dialyzer and is cleaned by passing it
through an artificial kidney.
HOW OFTEN IS IT DONE?
3 times a week, with each
session lasting for 4 hours
FOR HOW LONG IS IT DONE?
In cases of chronic renal failure
dialysis is done until a transplant
is possible. In some cases, dialysis
is done for the rest of the patient's life.
